Northwesterly along and approx. 60 ft. distant Southwesterly of CPCo's present existing elec. trans. line to a point not more than 450 ft. nor less than 250 ft. With full right and authority to the second party, its successors, licensees, lessees or assigns, and its and their agents and employees, to enter at all times upon said premises for the purpose of constructing, repairing, removing, replacing, patrolling, improving, enlarging and maintaining such cables, conduits and towers, poles and other supports, with all necessary braces, guys, anchors manholes and transformers, and stringing thereon and supporting and suspending therefrom lines of wire, cables or other conductors for the transmission of electrical energy and/or communication, and to trim, remove, destroy or otherwise control any trees and brush which may, in the opinion of said second party, interfere or threaten to interfere with or be hazardous to the construction, operation and maintenance of said lines.
