WITNESSETH:

The said first party for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to it in hand paid by the said second party, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, release and QUIT-CIAIM unto the said second party, its successors and assigns, Forever, the easement and right to erect, lay and maintain electric transmission lines consisting of poles, wires, cables, conduits and other fixtures and appurtenances for the purpose of transmitting and distributing electricity on, over, under and across the following described parcels of land, including all public highways upon or adjacent to said parcels of land, hereinafter more particularly described and on routes as hereinafter designated, situated in the Townships of Wilson and Green, Alpena County, State of Michigan, to-wit:
