Dear Sir:

In accordance with the general agreement dated February 20, 1941, as amended, between the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, Pennel Company, and the Consumers Power Company, covering wires, cables and appurtenances crossing your private right of way, the Consumers Power Company of Jackson, Michigan, hereby makes application for an aerial wire line crossing over your private right of way and tracks as follows:

3 - 266,800 cm ACSR wires to carry 140,000 Volts
1 - 5/16" Galv. Steel Grd. Wire

over your tracks and right of way at a point 85 feet southeast of Highway US-131, 680 feet northeast of the North - South Quarter Line of Section 25, T 30 N, R 6 W, Chestonia Township, Antrim County, Michigan.

Construction to be in accordance with rules and regulations of the Michigan Public Service Commission or any succeeding regulatory agency established by the State of Michigan.

Attached hereto are plans and specifications showing the proposed construction of this crossing.

Two copies of this application are sent to you, and would ask you to kindly endorse your Company's approval on one copy, and return to us together with waiver of notice of hearing thereon before the Michigan Public Service Commission so that we may receive a permit from that Commission to construct the crossing. This application, when approved by your Company, will serve as an acknowledgment that all the terms and conditions of said general agreement, as amended, shall apply with full force and effect and be made a part hereof.

Attached hereto is our check in the amount of \$150.00, in accordance with paragraph 13 of above-mentioned agreement.

Would be pleased to receive your approval, together with waiver of hearing, as soon as possible, and oblige.
