Hollister and Mildred Hollister, his wife; first part, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to them paid by the CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY, a Maine corporation authorized to do business in Michigan, at 212 W. Michigan Ave., Jackson, Michigan, second party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Convey and Warranty to the second party, its successors and assigns, Forever, the easement and right to erect, lay and maintain lines consisting of poles, wires, cables, conduits and other fixtures and appurtenances for the purpose of transmitting and distributing electricity and/or conducting a communication business on, over, under and across the following described parcel of land, including all public highways upon or adjacent to said parcel of land, which parcel is situate in the Township of Turner County of Arenac, and State of Michigan, to-wit:

That part of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 19, Township 20 North, Range 6 East, lying Easterly of the Detroit and Mackinac Railway right of way, except a strip of land 4 rods wide off the Westerly side thereof.

The route to be taken by said lines of poles, wires, cables and conduits across, over and under said land being more specifically described as follows: Second party may locate said route on, over and across said above described land, along or adjoining as near as practicable a line, which said line is described as beginning on the South line of said Section 19 at a point not more than 1300 feet nor less than 1200 feet East of the West line of said Section, running thence Northerly to a point not more than 116 feet Southeasterly of the Southeasterly line of the Detroit and Mackinac Railway right of way, at a point not more than 1300 feet nor less than 1200 feet East of the West line of said Section, running thence Northeasterly to the East and West quarter line of said Sec. 19 at a point not more than 116 feet Easterly of the Easterly line of said Railway right of way.

With full right and authority to the second party, its successors, licensees, lessees or assigns, and its and their agents and employees, to enter at all times upon said premises for the purpose of constructing, repairing, removing, replacing, patrolling, improving, enlarging and maintaining such cables, conduits and poles and other supports, with all necessary braces, guys, anchors manholes and transformers, and stringing thereon and supporting and suspending therefrom lines of wire, cables or other conductors for the transmission of electrical energy and/or communication, and to trim, remove, destroy or otherwise control any trees and brush which may, in the opinion of said second party, interfere or threaten to interfere with or be hazardous to the construction, operation and maintenance of said lines. It is expressly understood that no buildings or other structures will be placed under such wires and/or over such cables without the written consent of said second party. It is expressly understood that non-use or a limited use of this easement by second party shall not prevent second party from later making use of the easement to the full extent herein authorized. Second party to pay at the rate of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per mile of length of the line of poles and wires across said above described premises, the same to be paid before any work is done on the land, and also to pay for any damage to crops in erecting and maintaining said line of poles and wires.
