WITNESSETH: Whereas by agreement dated December 30, 1931 by and between THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY operating the Pennsylvania, Ohio and Detroit Railroad as Party of the First Part and the Utility Company as Party of the Second Part, the Utility Company acquired the right to construct, use, maintain, renew and remove a certain wire and/or cable crossing in and across certain land of said The Pennsylvania Railroad Company lying between Madola and Molena Avenues in the City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, and

Whereas, on even date herewith Elliman has acquired the fee title of said land from said The Pennsylvania Railroad Company and Pennsylvania. Ohio and Detroit Railroad.

Now therefore, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the said agreement be and the same is hereby amended by adding therein a paragraph as follows:

SIXTEENTH: The Railroad, it successors, grantees and assigns shall have the right to terminate this agreement at any time by giving to the Utility Company sixty (60) days notice in writing of such termination.

And it is further mutually agreed that anything contained in said agreement inconsistent with the foregoing amendment be and the same is hereby cancelled.


