## CONTRACTOR NO. 12. 7555 A

## Norfolk and Western Railway Company

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into the 4th. day of October , 1972 between NORFOLK AND WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY ("Railway") and THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY ("Licensee");

WHEREAS, Licensee desires to occupy the right of way of Railway with a 120/230 KV transmission line and Railway being willing to grant said privilege upon terms and conditions hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AND THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the premises, payment of an initial fee of \$ 100.00 annual fee of \$ 196.00

and also an

payable on the 4th.day of October of each year, Railway doth hereby grant to Licensee the right and privilege of installing, maintaining, operating and removing a 120/230 KV transmission line over or on the right of way of Railway at Detroit, Michigan on its Ft. Wayne Division, the same to be located in accordance with Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Said right and privilege is granted subject also to the following specifications and conditions upon which the right and privilege shall be enjoyed by Licensee and the breach of any of which shall render this agreement and the right and privilege hereby granted null and void.

- 1. One steel transmission tower will be placed on the right of way of Railway.
- 2. The said facilities to be placed over or on the premises of Railway shall be such as its Chief Engineer shall approve, and shall be kept in good order by Licensee at its sole cost and as Railway's Chief Engineer may from time to time prescribe.
- 3. The minimum clearances of the 230 KV/ shall be no less than 37 feet above the top of the rail and 12 feet from Railway pole line wires and, except for the foregoing, construction shall meet all applicable Safety Rules of the latest edition of the National Electrical Safety Code for the Installation and Maintenance of Electric Supply and Communication Lines.
- 4. The said facilities shall be removed from said premises within sixty (60) days following notice by the Chief Engineer of Railway to Licensee that such removal is required; or in default of such removal within said sixty (60) day period said facilities shall become the property of Railway without any claim or consideration what-soever therefor by Licensee, its heirs, successors or assigns, and may be removed from said premises by Railway without further notice.


- 5. Railway shall not be responsible in any way for any damage including, without limitation, damage to said facilities or other apparatus or any part thereof by fire or any other casualty whatever, resulting directly or indirectly from Railway's operations near said facilities or other apparatus or otherwise.
- 6. If Railway, its successors or assigns, shall make any change on its right of way at or near said facilities of Licensee affecting the character, height or alignment of any of Railway's power lines, communication, signal or other wires or electrical apparatus, or shall place structures or additional wires or electrical apparatus upon its said right of way, or shall make on its said right of way any change in its track or structures or in the use thereof, which would be affected by the then existing facilities of Licensee or by the use thereof, Licensee shall promptly, at its own expense, make such changes in the location and character of its facilities as in the opinion of the Chief Engineer of Railway, its successors or assigns, shall be necessary on account of any such changes or additions.
- 7. Licensee hereby agrees to indemnify and save harmless Railway against any and all loss or damage, accidents or injuries, including death, to persons or property, whether of Railway or of any other persons or corporations, arising in any manner from the installation, maintenance, operation or removal or failure to properly install, maintain, operate or remove the above-described facilities, unless such loss, damage or injuries shall be caused solely by the negligence of Railway.
  - 8. No fee adjustment refunds of \$12 or less will be made.
- 9. This agreement cancels and supersedes agreement Document No. W-8691, dated December 15, 1955.


