IN. CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in Township of Scio

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Washtenaw, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Commencing at the E. 1/4 post of Section 25, T.2S., R.5E., thence north in the east line of said Section 895.64 feet; thence N. 67° 51' W. 621.62 feet; thence N. 66° 07' W. 257.30 feet; thence N. 23° 53' E. 33.00 feet to a point in the north line of the former Detroit United Railway right-of-way, which is also the northerly line of U.S. 12 Highway for a place of beginning; thence continuing N. 23° 53' E. 220.0 feet; thence S. 66° 07' E. 200 feet; thence S. 23° 53' W. 220.0 feet to the north line of the old Detroit United Railway right-of-way; thence N. 66° 07' W., along the northerly line of the former Detroit United Railway right-of-way which is also the northerly line of U.S. 12 Highway 200.0 feet to the place of beginning, being a part of the E. 1/2 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 25.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: ~~In a northerly and southerly direction across the southwest corner of the above described property.~~

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood and agreed that should the electric lines, poles, wires, cables, guys, stub poles, fixtures and apparatus or any of them at any time interfere with the operation or development of the premises, then the Company, shall within 60 days after notice in writing, at its own expense, remove or relocate the electric lines, poles, wires, cables, guys, stub poles, etc., to another satisfactory location to be designated by owner.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
