EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS IS AN AGREEMENT dated July 18 , 1973, between

WOLVERINE PIPE LINE COMPANY, a Delaware corporation ("Wolverine") with offices

at Two Shell Plaza (P. O. Box 2648) in Houston, Texas 77001, and THE DETROIT
a corporation organized and existing concurrently under the laws of

EDISON COMPANY, / axNewxYerkxerxerxexxerine ("Detroit Edison") with offices at Michigan and
New York,

WOLVERINE, for good and valuable consideration received, hereby grants to Detroit Edison easements to construct, reconstruct, maintain, operate and remove:

A. An electric transmission and/or distribution line (including necessary poles, guys, anchors, wires and other appurtenant equipment), on and across the land of Wolverine in the West Half of the Northwest Ouarter of Section 16, T. 3 S., R. 4 E., in Freedom Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, within the strips thereof, twenty feet in width, lying ten feet on either side of the following-described line ("Line Area"):

Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 16 (Ellsworth Road), South 89° 22' East 636.3 feet from the Northwest corner of said Section 16;

Thence South 01° 36' West 415.0 feet to a point;

Thence North 88° 20' West 478.1 feet to a point;

Thence North 01° 40' West 4.7 feet to a point of

ending, said point being South 00° 53' West 407.30 feet and South 88° 20' East 156.55 feet from the Northwest corner of said Section 16.

B. An electric substation (including all necessary facilities appurtenant thereto) within the following-described 50-foot by 75-foot rectangular portion of that same land of Wolverine, containing 0.086 acre, more or less ("Substation Area"):

Beginning at the point which is South 00° 53' West along the West line of Section 16 (Fletcher Road) 407.30 feet and South 88° 20' East 156.55 feet from the Northwest corner of said Section 16;

Thence continuing South 88° 20' East 50.00 feet to a point for a corner;

Thence North 01° 40' East 75.00 feet to a point for a corner;

Thence North $88^{\circ}\ 20^{\dagger}\ \text{West }50.00$ feet to a point for a corner; and

Thence South 01° 40' West 75.00 feet to the point of beginning;

together with the rights: (a) to remove trees or parts thereof which, in Detroit Edison's judgment, do or may interfere with its facilities in the Line Area or the Substation Area; and (b) of ingress and egress to and from the Line Area and the Substation Area for any purposes necessary or convenient

to Detroit Edison's exercise of the easements and rights hereby granted; provided that if, now or ever and so long as, there are established ways on Wolverine's land giving access to the Line Area and the Substation Area, such rights of ingress and egress shall be limited to those ways;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD such easements and rights unto Detroit Edison and its successors and assigns, so long as the same are continuously exercised; subject always, however, to the following conditions and covenants:

- This grant is subject to all easements and encumbrances of record, and without any warranties of title to the land; and Wolverine reserves the right to use and enjoy its land in all ways that do not unreasonably interfere with Detroit Edison's exercise of the easements and rights hereby granted.
- 2. All facilities and other property ever placed by Detroit Edison on the Line Area or the Substation Area shall be and remain Detroit Edison's property, notwithstanding any attachment thereof to the land; and Detroit Edison shall pay all, or reimburse Wolverine for its payment of any, taxes, assessments or other governmental charges ever imposed on that property.
- 3. Detroit Edison shall defend and indemnify Wolverine against all claims, suits, liabilities, losses and expenses on account of injury or death of persons or damage to property (including Wolverine's), and liens on Wolverine's land, caused by or arising out of any exercise of the easements and rights hereby granted, and not solely by or out of any negligence of its officers, agents, employes or representatives
 Wolverine/;provided that Detroit Edison's liability under this indemnity shall never include any indirect or consequential damages, nor any liability which it may not incur without violating governmental laws, regulations, or orders applicable to it as a public utility; nor shall this indemnity ever give any third party any claim to which such party would not otherwise be lawfully entitled.
- 4. This Agreement may not be assigned by Detroit Edison without Wolverine's prior written consent (which shall never be unreasonably withheld); but subject thereto shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Wolverine and Detroit Edison, respectively.




