Gentlemen:

Your request for three phase, underground electric service to the above stated project and location, is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions.

- 1. You will furnish and install primary ducts from the property line or three phase source if on your property, to the transformer location, including trenching and backfilling. You will also install the transformer foundation.
- A property layout plan suitable for indicating the route of the cable and associated equipment must be provided. Rights of Way encompassing an area three feet each side of the cable and associated equipment as installed, must be granted herewith.
- 3. In addition to the Rights of Way out forth in Item 2 above, the ewnoreagree to grant by separate instrument, additional Rights of Way doesnotnecessary for the extension of electric facilities.
- 4. The Detroit Edison Company will install, own and maintain the primary cable, the transformer, and will maintain the transformer foundation. Service cable requirements will be fulfilled as per our rules and rates as filed with the Michigan Public Service Commission and as shown in our current rate book.
- 5. The cost to you for said underground electric line and equipment installation is \$\frac{780.00}{2000}\$ based on \$\frac{390}{2000}\$ trench feet for primary and/or secondary cable. Extra charges in addition to the above will be \$\frac{9}{2000}\$ as your contribution for such items as boring under paved streets, line extensions onto private property exceeding three hundred (300) feet, providing cable on cable pole, providing primary mains, distribution laterals and primary switching cabinets. These extra charges will only be assessed if involved. All charges are based on rules and rates as filed with the Michigan Public Service Commission and as shown in our current rate book. We will require full payment of the aforementioned charges prior to energizing the system.


