- 1. Facilities must conform with all Federal, State and local laws, rules and regulations and will not be attached to any Railroad structure or appurtenance and will not otherwise be located on any private property of the Railroad.
- 2. In the event of any revision, renewal, addition or alteration of said facilities, prior approval of the Railroad must be secured.
- 3. Facilities will be installed, maintained, repaired and renewed by and at the sole risk, cost and expense of the OWNER.
- 4. If the Railroad deems it advisable during the progress of any work of construction. maintenance, repairs and renewals, alterations, adjustments or removal of the facilities and appurtenances of the OWNER, or in the event of emergency, to place watchmen, flagmen, inspectors or any other employees deemed necessary by Railroad for the protection of the property owned or in possession or control of the Railroad, or its employees, patrons, or licensees, the Railroad shall have the right to do so. The OWNER agrees to pay to Railroad the actual cost of material plus the current applicable overhead percentages for storage. handling, transportation, purchasing and other related material management expenses and the actual cost of labor plus the current applicable overhead percentages as developed and published by the Accounting Department of Railroad for fringe benefits, payroll taxes, administration, supervision, use of tools, machinery and other equipment, supplies, employers! liability insurance, public liability insurance, and other insurance, taxes and all other indirect expenses. It is to be understood that the aforementioned material and labor over head charges are to be applied at the rates which are effective at the time of the perform ance of any work by employees of the Railroad on the said facilities. The OWNER agrees to pay such bills within thirty (30) days of the presentation thereof by Railroad. Failure of the Railroad to provide such watchmen, flagmen, inspectors or any other employees of Railroad, shall in no event be construed as in any manner or degree affecting any obligations of the OWNER as provided for elsewhere in these conditions.

All cost or expense resulting from any and all loss of life or property, or injury or damage to the person or property of any person, firm or corporation (including the parties hereto and their respective officers, agents and employees) and any and all claims, demands or actions for such loss, injury or damage, caused by or growing out of the presence or use, or the construction, maintenance, renewal, change or relocation and subsequent removal of said facilities and appurtenances herein referred to, caused by or from the joint or concurring negligence of both parties hereto shall be borne by them equally; if, however, any such loss, injury or damage shall be attributed to the negligence of one of the parties hereto, where solely or combined with the negligence of any other person or corporation not a party hereto, and without the concurring fault or negligence of the other party hereto, then such party hereto which by its fault, or negligence contributed thereto shall indemnify, protect and save harmless the other party hereto therefrom.

Those of us within the utility industry who request permits, licenses, etc., from the railroad, realize there is a three or four month period of time in which the railroad requires to process the requests through the various interested departments.

Unfortunately, not all projects can enjoy this amount of lead time. Such is the case of the subject underground crossing. This facility was requested by the City of Monroe and had to be completed within a specific time frame. As you can see by the enclosed letter they, the city, were quite active in the coordination with the local railroad representatives in securing the approval to construct the underground facilities.

We had a call October 5, 1977 from Mr. Don French, City Manager of the City of Monroe, Michigan in regard to your application dated September 1, 1977 for crossing the Monroe Branch of our railroad at Valuation Station 1515+50 (on First Street, Monroe) with four (4) 5" ducts encased in a concrete envelope to contain 4.8 KV and 13.2 KV cables.

Mr. French stated that he hoped this project would be expedited and said that he would inform you to get in touch with our Mr. Mason to discuss what problems there might be.

Our Contract Bureau has not been able to locate the agreement you mentioned in your letter of September 1st, and expect that the June 4, 1954 date is that of a supplement to an original agreement of another date.

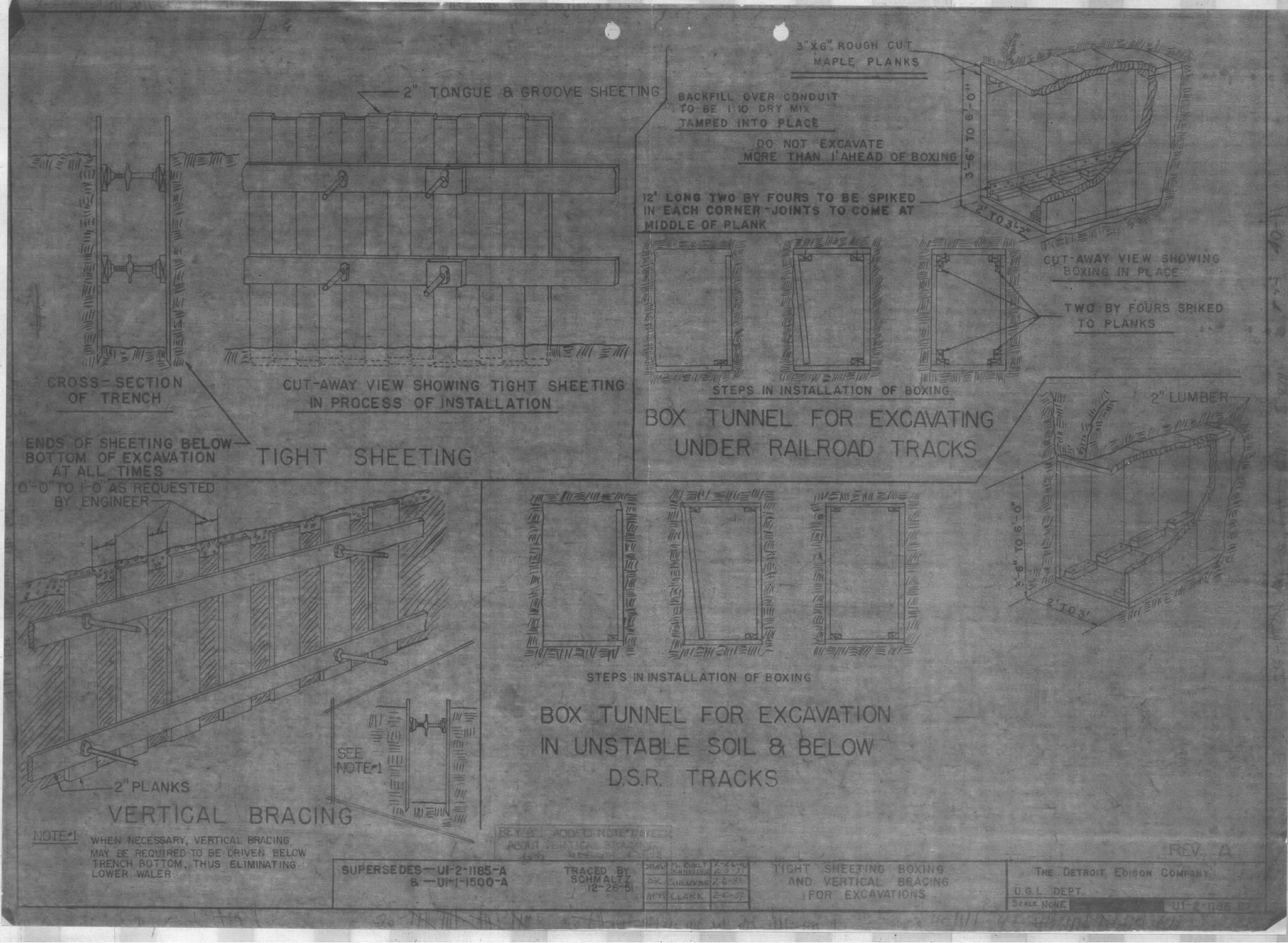

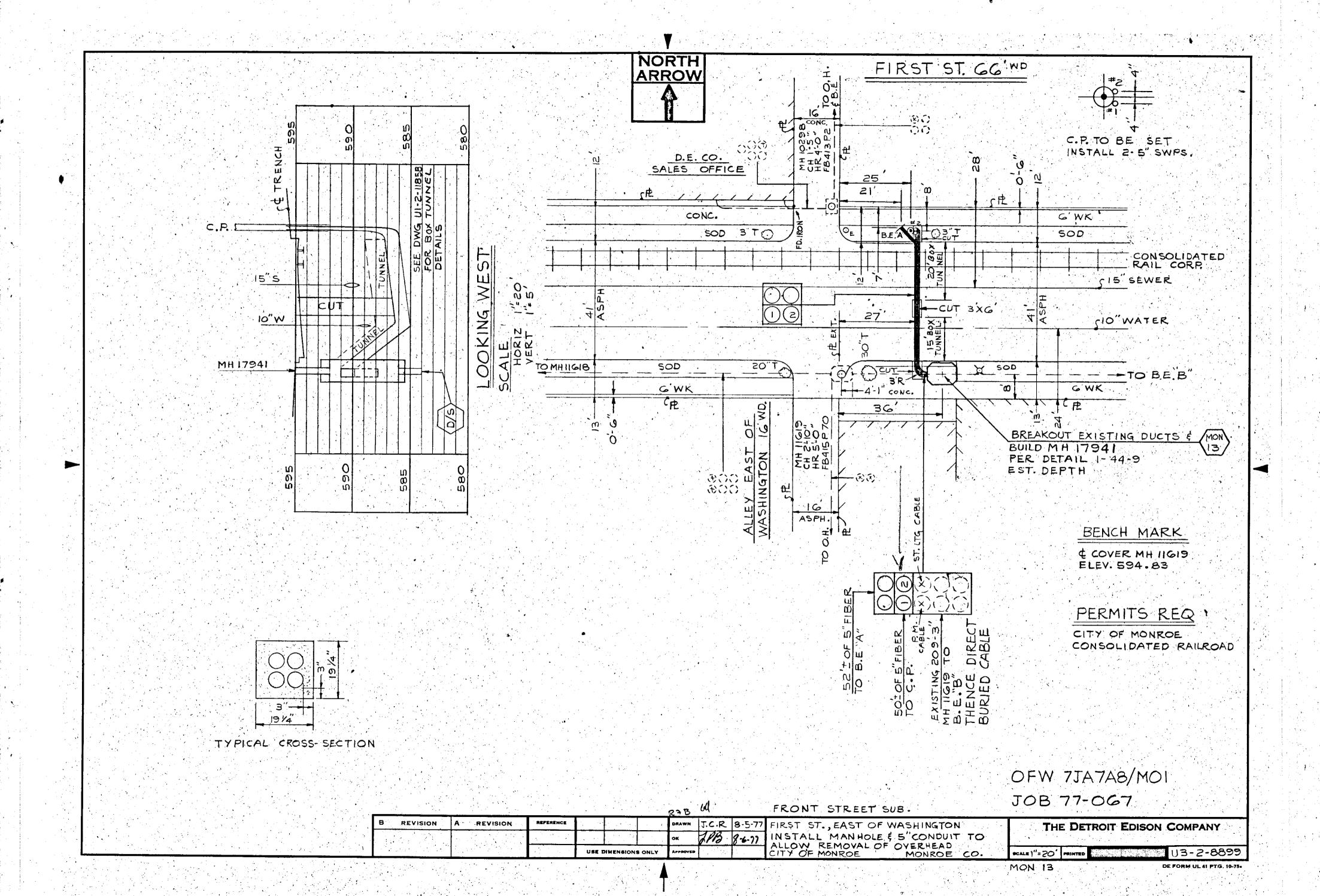
