



All cost or expense resulting from any and all loss of life or property, or injury or damage to the person or property of any person, firm or corporation (including the parties hereto and their respective officers, agents and employees) and any and all claims, demands or actions for such loss, injury or damage, caused by or growing out of the presence or use, or the construction, maintenance, renewal, change or relocation and subsequent removal of said facilities and appurtenances herein referred to, caused by or from the joint or concurring negligence of both parties hereto shall be borne by them equally; if, however, any such loss, injury or damage shall be attributed to the negligence of one of the parties hereto, where solely or combined with the negligence of any other person or corporation not a party hereto, and without the concurring fault or negligence of the other party hereto, then such party hereto which by its fault, or negligence contributed thereto shall indemnify, protect and save harmless the other party hereto therefrom.
- 6. Upon abandonment of the facilities, the same shall be removed and the property of the Railroad shall be restored to good condition and this instrument shall become null and void, save and except only as to any liability accrued prior thereto.
- 7. All rights and obligations conferred hereby shall extend to the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, provided that the owner shall in no event transfer or assign its rights hereunder without the written consent of Railroad".


