UNDERGROUND EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) NO. AS-7131

, 1991, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent underground easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226

"Grantor's Land" is in Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan described as:

Commencing at the South ¼ corner of Section 8, T3S, R6E, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence N 00°57'10" W 1000.62 feet along the North & South 1/4 line of said Section; thence S 89°02'50" W 250.00 feet to the Point of Beginning: thence continuing S 89°02'50" W 207.80 feet to a point on the Easterly Right of Way line of Oak Valley Drive; thence along said Right of Way line in the following three (3) courses: Northerly 90.09 feet along the arc of a 340.85 foot radius circular curve to the left, through a central angle of 15°08'35" having a chord which bears N 11°12'20" W 89.82 feet, N 5° 18°46'40" W 150.00 feet and Northerly 121.85 feet along the arc of a 648.56 foot radius circular curve to the right, through a central angle of 10°45'50" having a chord which bears N 13°23'45" W 121.67 feet; thence N 89°02'50" E 295.92 feet; thence S, 00°57'10" E 350.00 feet to the Point of Beginning. Being a part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 8, T3S, R6E, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michign and containing 2.02 acres of land, more or less.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land described as:

As shown on Detroit Edison Drawing AS-7131 and dated 07/31/91, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The width of Right of Way is twelve (12) feet.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Excavation: As required by Public Act 53 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area.

 5. Trees Bushes Branches Roots Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim cut down remove or otherwise control any
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
