RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to petition and in accordance with the provisions of Section 18, Chapter IV, Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, the Wayne County Department of Public Services has determined that all the occupants and adjoining owners have signed a petition to vacate the property herein described; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said petition, the County Executive had determined that it is advisable to absolutely abandon and discontinue:

That part of Boyce Drive (formerly Beach Drive East) as dedicated to the use of the public in "MAPLE BEACH SUBDIVISION" of part of the N.E. 1/4 of Fr'1. Section 24, T.5 S., R., 10 E., Brownstown Twp., Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 46 of Plats on Page 25, Wayne County Records -- which lies between the west line of Lake Drive and the west boundary of the subdivision and adjacent to Lots 2 and 3;

and

WHEREAS, the premises were reviewed in accordance with said statute;

Now therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Wayne County Commission this 25th day of July, 1991 that the County Commission hereby declares it is in the best interest of the public that the above described County Road be absolutely abandoned and discontinued, and that pursuant thereto said Road is hereby absolutely abandoned and discontinued, reserving therein an easement for existing public utilities and sewer purposes.
