The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan Corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, MI 48226 and Michigan Bell Telephone Company, a Michigan corporation, 444 Michigan Avenue, Detroit, MI 48226.

Grantor's Land" is in the City of Grosse Pointe Farms, Wayne County, Michigan described as:

Lot 212 of Radnor Park Subdivision of parts of P.C.s 584 and 258 sometimes called 558, Village of Grosse Pointe Farms as recorded in Liber 65, Page 1 of Plats, Wayne County Records.

Transformer is collectively:

The transformer and switching cabinet with respect to which Grantor hereby gives Grantee an easement to locate on Grantor's Land in the Right of Way Area on a cement pad having dimensions of approximately 6' X 12'.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land described as:

The northerly 20.0 feet of the southerly 77.0 feet of the easterly 20.0 feet, as measured along and parallel with the adjacent 30 foot wide public drive.

1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this Easement and Right of Way is to allow Grantee to locate the Transformer on Grantor's Land in the Right of Way Area and to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities

consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.

- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Excavation: As required by Public Act 53 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's Transformer and facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of Transformer. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of Transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
- 8. Relocation: On ninety (90) days' written notice from Grantor and for good reason, in Grantor's sole discretion, Grantee shall relocate Grantee's Transformer to make way for improvements on Grantor's land.
