

OVERHEAD AND UNDERGROUND EASEMENT (R/W) NO. R-9500093-02

On 3 3 4 , 1995, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead and underground easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of "Grantor" is:

Joseph D. Linck, a single man, 5182 Hasslick Rd., North Branch, MI 48461

"Grantee" is:

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226

"Grantor's Land" is in North Branch Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

PARCEL "A": Part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, T9N-R11E, described as beginning at a point on the North section line that is WEST 636.15 feet from the North 1/4 corner of said Section 26; thence South 00°17'21" East 609.83 feet; thence North 88°40'47" West 145.98 feet; thence South 02°17'50" West 618.55 feet; thence South 42°47'22" East 113.66 feet thence South 89°43'51" West 579.45 feet; thence along the West line of said East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4, North 00°06'13" West 439.45 feet; thence EAST 175.00 feet; thence North 00°06'13" West 871.20 feet; thence along the North section line, EAST 497.26 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to and including rights of ingress and egress over "Easement" as described herein.

EASEMENT: An easement for ingress and egress, 66 feet in width, being part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, T9N-R11E, the centerline of which is described as beginning at a point on the North section line that is WEST 669.15 from the North 1/4 corner of said Section 26; thence South 00°17′21″East 576.07 feet; thence North 88°40′47″West 111.48 feet; thence South 02°17′50″West 651.55 feet; thence South 42°47′22″East 113.66 feet to the point of termination.

The Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as: Shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead and underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Excavation: As required by Public Act 53 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
