## "Grantor's Land" is in Elba Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

Part of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 4, T7N-R9E, described as beginning at a point on the centerline of Davison Road that is North 01°08'32" East 317.50 feet along the West section line and North 85°51'10" East 449.05 feet along said centerline of Davison Road from the Southwest corner of Section 4; thence continuing along said centerline of Davison Road, North 85°51'10" East 471.25 feet; thence North 01°05'34" East 250.28 feet; thence South 85°49'08" West 471.06 feet; thence South 01°08'32" West 250.02 feet to the point of beginning.

## The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 6. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
