Part of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 34, T7N-R12E, described as beginning at a point on the East line of Section 34, T7N-R12E, that is North 02°10'47" East 660.46 feet from the East 1/4 corner of said Section 34; thence North 89°39'46" West 324.10 feet; thence North 02°10'47" East 330.23 feet; thence South 89°39'46" East 324.10 feet to a point on the East line of said Section 34; thence South 02°10'47" West 330.23 feet along said East line to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 6. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
