OVERHEAD EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) NO. 19648

On **DECEMBER 18**, 1995, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

"Grantor" is:

Philip Furgerson and Sherrill M. Furgerson, husband and wife, 4360 Rochester Rd., Dryden, MI 48428 "Grantee" is:

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226 "Grantor's Land" is in Dryden Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

Section 15, T6N-R11E, being the East 80 acres of the North 112 acres of the Southeast 1/4 and the North 22.85 acres of the West 32 acres of the North 112 acres of the Southeast 1/4 excepting the North 416 feet of the East 1,050 feet to the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and except commencing 616 feet South 00°14'30" West from the East 1/4 corner of the Section; thence South 00°14'30" West 200.00 feet; thence North 89°05'22" West 435.60 feet; thence North 00°14'30" East 200.00 feet; thence South 89°05'22" East 435.60 feet to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 6. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
