

## OVERHEAD EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) NO. 18705/5

On X January 6, 1996, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

"Grantor" is:

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226

## "Grantor's Land" is in Lapeer Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

PARCEL 15C: Part of the Northwest fractional 1/4 of Section 2, T7N-R10E, described as beginning at a point that is South 00°03'10" West 1560.46 feet along the West section line and South 89°17'45" East 556.73 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 2; thence continuing South 89°17'45" East 251.45 feet; thence North 00°03'10" East 346.50 feet; thence North 89°17'45" West 251.45 feet; thence South 00°03'10" West 346.50 feet to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 6. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
