On 5/19/96, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent underground easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226

"Grantor's Land" is in Dryden Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

PARCEL 2: Part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, T6N-R11E, described as beginning at a point on the East line of Section 25, T6N-R11E, that is North 02°58'16" East 648.59 feet from the East 1/4 corner of said Section 25; thence South 89°50'12" West 1328.10 feet; thence North 03°09'12" East 330 feet; thence North 89°50'03" East 1327.05 feet to a point on the East line of said Section 25; thence along said East line, South 02°58'16" West 330 feet to the point of beginning. Contains 10.041 acres. Reserving therefrom any portion deeded, taken or used for road purposes and subject to easements and restrictions of record, if any.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 15' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.

- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- **4. Excavation:** As required by Public Act 53 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.

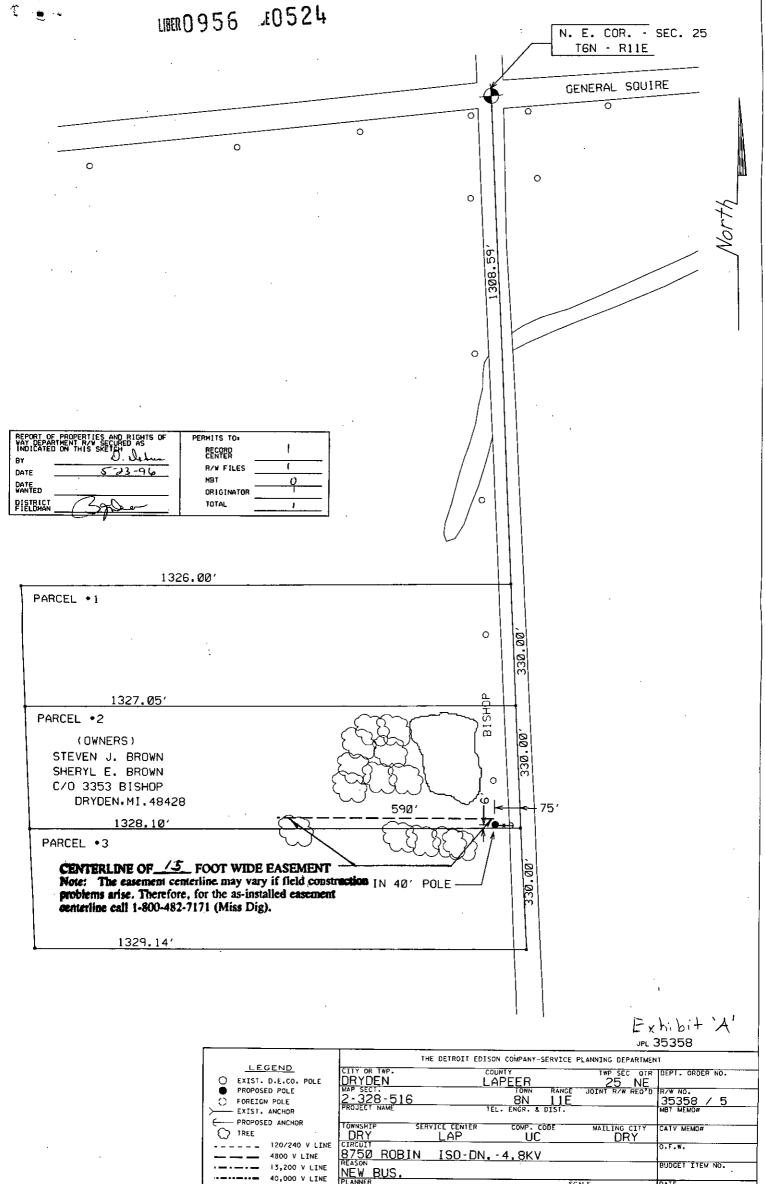
