OVERHEAD EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) NO. 48100 REGISTER OF DEEDS

On 21-May-96, 1996, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

"Grantor's Land" is in Elba Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

Commencing at a point 13 1/3 rods South of the Northeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 7, T7N-R9E, thence South 26 2/3 rods, thence West 24 rods, thence North 26 2/3 rods, thence East 24 rods to beginning. Except commencing at a point 13 1/3 rods South of the Northeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 7, thence South 80 feet, thence West 24 rods; thence North 80 feet, thence East 24 rods to the point of beginning; and also Except beginning at a point on the East line of said Section 7 which is South 551.30 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 7, thence North 89°44' West 404.11 feet, thence South 00°05' West 100 feet, thence South 89°44' East 404.25 feet to the East line of said Section 7, thence North 100 feet to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

- A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
 - 1. Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
 - 2. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
 - 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
 - 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
 - 5. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
 - 6. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
