

OVERHEAD EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) NO. 51222

On $\int u/y S$, 1996, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area".

"Grantee" is: The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226
"Grantor's Land" is in AUGUSTA TOWNSHIP, WASHTENAW County, described as: THAT PART OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 24, T4S, R7E, AUGUSTA TOWNSHIP, WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN, DESCRIBED AS: BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 24 AND PROCEEDING THENCE NORTH 89°54'00" EAST ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 24, 221.36 FEET; THENCE DUE NORTH 371.00 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89°54'00" WEST 221.36 FEET; THENCE DUE SOUTH ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID SECTION 24, 371.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as: A TWELVE FOOT WIDE EASEMENT AS SHOWN ON D.E. DWG. 51222.
 Purpose The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories. Access Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area. Buildings or other Permanent Structures No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. Restoration If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition. Successors This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
