OVERHEAD ELECTRIC FACILITY EASEMENT

On December 28, 1992, for one dollar and other valuable consideration and in further consideration of Grantee keeping and performing the promises and conditions in this Easement Agreement, Grantor grants to Grantee to the extent the title of Grantor so

Grantor grants to Grantee to the extent the title of Grantor so permits a non-exclusive, permanent easement only for the actual physical space required for the current physical facilities on land called the Easement Area.

a Michigan Corporation, 644 East Huron Avenue, Bad Axe, Michigan 48413

Grantee is: The Detroit Edison Company (Edison), a Michigan

Corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Room 2310 WCB,

Huron and Eastern Railway Company, Inc. (H&E)

Detroit, Michigan 48226

The "Easement Area" is described as:

Grantor is:

A strip of land 23 feet wide (for lines of 120 kV and greater) or 12 feet wide (for lines of less than 120 kV) the centerline of which is the centerline of the existing overhead pole or tower facilities over, across, along the Grantor's land at various locations as described in the separate license agreements which are listed on the attached Appendix A. The location and construction plans referred to in the separate license agreements identify the location of Edison facilities and are made a part of this Easement Agreement.

Introduction

Grantee has previously signed separate license agreements (Appendix A) which generally provide for annual payments to construct, install maintain and use certain crossings and occupations at various locations over or across the Grantor's land. Grantor and Grantee are now replacing these agreements with annual payments with this one permanent and irrevocable Easement Agreement.

Purpose

Grantor grants this easement to Grantee and will allow Grantee upon notice to Grantor to enter the Easement Area at all reasonable times, to reconstruct, modify, add to, operate, remove and maintain electric power transmission lines including towers, poles, wires, cables, transformers and accessories. ("Grantee's Facility").

Grantor's Rights

- a). Grantor reserves to itself, its successors and assigns, the right to continue to occupy, possess and use the land upon which the easement is imposed for railroad purposes consistent with Grantor's railroad operations and needs which are not inconsistent with or which do not interfere with or impair the right granted by this Easement Agreement.
- b). Grantor has the right to require Grantee to perform needed work to protect the general public and the continued safe operation of Grantor's railroad. Grantee, as soon as reasonably possible following written notice from Grantor, will initiate steps to strengthen, support, protect or modify Grantee's Facility and then promptly complete the work. This requested action will be referred to in this Easement Agreement as a "Modification".

This includes, but is not limited to the right to use, construct, reconstruct, relocate, operate, maintain, repair, renew, replace, and remove Grantor's tracks, and other railroad facilities as now exist or which may in the future be located in, upon, over, under or across the Easement Area.

<u>Indemnity</u>

To the extent of its negligent acts Grantee shall indemnify, save harmless and defend (at grantor's option) Grantor from and against all cost and expense arising from, or in connection with, any and all losses, damages, detriments, suits, claims, demands, costs and charges which Grantor may directly or indirectly suffer, sustain, or be subjected to by reason of the construction, placement, attachment, presence, use, maintenance, repair, alteration, renewal, relocation, replacement, or removal of Grantee's Facility in, on, about, under, over or from the Grantor's property, whether such loss and damage be suffered or sustained by Grantor or by its patrons, or licensees, or other person or entities, including Grantee, its patrons, and licensees. If such loss or injury is attributable to the joint or concurrent negligence of Grantor or Grantee, each party shall bear liability in proportion to its respective degree of negligence.

Grantee's Obligations

Grantee must at all times promptly maintain, repair and renew Grantee's Facility; and shall promptly make such repairs and renewals to Grantee's Facility as may be required, as soon as is reasonably possible.

Construction and Maintenance

a). Grantee will reconstruct and maintain, repair, alter, renew, replace, or remove Grantee's Facility in the Easement Area at its sole expense.

Except for emergency repairs, Grantee will submit plans and notify Grantor or representative of Grantor before Grantee reconstructs, maintains, revises, replaces, adds to, alters or performs any Modification to Grantee's Facility. Grantee must perform all work in a satisfactory manner.

It is further agreed, for transverse crossings only, Grantee may replace existing FACILITIES with similar FACILITIES involving

higher voltage up to a maximum of 40kV.

Grantor has the right to require flagmen, watchmen or inspectors if Grantor believes they are required to protect Grantor's operations or property or its employees, patrons, or maintenance, repair, installation, the during alteration, renewal, replacement or removal of Grantee's facility. Grantee shall furnish watchers to keep persons equipment and materials a safe distance from Grantor's tracks and operation. These watchers shall use red flags, fusees or laterns one mile before any work area, as required.

Emergencies

Grantee shall take prompt steps to perform any necessary repairs and notify Grantor promptly after completion or prior to the work if possible by calling (800) 968-1975.

Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.

Trees, Bushes, Branches, or Roots:

Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow in the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interferes with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.

Restoration:

If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.

Requests to Obtain Additional Easements

Grantee may buy additional easements as amendments to this Easement Agreement. Grantee will pay Grantor a negotiated lump-sum easement fee.

Mortgage:

This easement is subject to any existing mortgages between Huron and Eastern Railway Company and its lenders.

Successors:

This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.

As previously indicated, Detroit Edison will pay Huron and Eastern a one-time payment to retire these annual payments and convert the license rights to easement rights, with a financial closing in early January 1993. The easement will be effective December 28, 1992.

Subject: Available RR easement in Sandusky

An opportunity has recently developed in Sandusky due to the removal of the Huron and Eastern RR tracks across the northern edge of Sandusky. At the present time most of the developing commercial load growth is on the west side of Sandusky along M-46. This area is fed by our 13.2kV Sandusky circuit. However, the route from the substation to the load is south from substation for one mile, west to M-19 for one-half mile and then back north and west to the developing load through side streets and alleys (refer to attached map). Most of the latter route is #2 copper on older poles. This portion of the circuit was converted as relief to the 4.8kV substation about ten years ago.

Huron Eastern Railway has offered Detroit Edison a permanent easement on the route before they make the property available to adjacent land owners. Mortimer Lumber has expressed an interest in expanding into the area adjacent to their yard and Yale Rubber has already purchased the most westerly 400 feet of the available one mile of easement.

Installation of a 13.2kV feeder in this route would be of immediate value to us for voltage, capacity and reliability improvement in the Sandusky area. However, for budgetary considerations we probably can delay the line for approximately three years depending on growth activity in the developing area. The asking price for the one mile of easement was \$10,000, but Tom Wilson of Corporate Real Estate has negotiated a lower price of \$5,000 which has been accepted by the railroad.

The capital cost of the new line will be approximately \$90,000 in 1995 or 1996 and the alternative cost to rebuild the existing route will cost about \$200,000 in 1997. Although the purchase of the easement will be an early investment it is our recommendation that the \$5,000 be made available as soon as possible since the railroad plans to dispose of the land by the end of the year.

A net present value study was completed showing a positive result of 113 with a payback in 1994 for the purchase of the easement. The loss of the easement and reconstruction of the existing longer route has an NPV of -42 with no payback.

PARTIAL ASSIGNMENT OF EASEMENT RIGHTS

THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a Michigan corporation, of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226 (hereinafter called "Detroit Edison") for good and valuable consideration hereby conveys, assigns and quitclaims to International Transmission Company, a Michigan corporation, of 39500 Orchard Hill Place, Suite 200, Novi, Michigan 48375 (hereinafter called "ITC*Transmission*") its successors and assigns, forever, certain easement rights and all right, title and interest of Detroit Edison in an easement for electric lines operated at 120 kV and known as the "Cosmo Tap" which easement is described as:

A twenty-three(23) foot wide easement along the north side of The Huron and Eastern Railway right-of-way located in Sections 8 and 9 and along the south side of said railroad right-of-way located in Sections 9, 10, 15, 14 and 13 all in the Township of Oliver and also on the south side of the railroad right-of-way located in Sections 18, 17, 16 and 15 in the Township of Colfax, Huron County, Michigan

as described in the Overhead Facility Easement from Huron and Eastern Railway Co. Incorporated as recorded October 20, 1993 in Liber 502 Page 299 and the Addendum to Easement between Huron and Eastern Railway Co. Incorporated, as Grantor and The Detroit Edison Company, as Grantee, dated September 20, 1996 and recorded December 13, 1996 in Liber 685 page 758 Huron County Register of Deeds.

And also any right title and interest Detroit Edison may have in the Thomas Road right-of-way accommodating its equipment from ITC*Transmission*'s line north approximately 350 feet to the railroad easement.

The overhead electric line described herein ("Cosmo Tap") is a 120 kV overhead electric line extending from ITC*Transmission*'s Arrowhead/Bad Axe line at tap switch pole No. 6326 near Thomas Road in Colfax Township, Huron County, Michigan and extending approximately ten miles to the Harvest Wind Farm Substation located at Maxwell Road in Oliver County.

It is understood and agreed that the easement described herein may accommodate both transmission facilities (120kV or higher)and distribution facilities (less than 120 kV), whether currently built as such or not, and whether currently energized or not, Detroit Edison reserves unto itself, its successors and any future assignees, those distribution rights. Therfore,



ITCTransmission, as assignee, takes subject to the right of Detroit Edison to utilize these easements for distribution purposes.

It is further understood that Detroit Edison may need to access the property covered by the easement described herein if ITCTransmission requires Detroit Edison to move the Facilities; therefore, Detroit Edison reserves unto itself, and ITCTransmission takes subject to the right of Detroit Edison to access the easement property to move the Facilities.

Detroit Edison covenants and agrees that (i) Detroit Edison has the lawful right to transfer said easement rights, and (ii) Detroit Edison has not, through its own act or omission, impaired the transferability of said easement rights.

The assignment of said easement rights shall be subject to all interests, agreement and encroachments currently existing on the properties encumbered by said easement.
