

## Detroit Edison Overhead Easement (Right of Way) No. 232284/5

On 50 1, 2, 1999, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area."
"Grantor" is:  James and Loretta Kamlay, 1895 Bauman Road, Columbus, MI 48063-2907
"Grantee" is: The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226
"Grantor's Land" is in Columbus Township, St. Clair County, Michigan described as:  SECTION 20 A PART OF THE SOUEAST 1/4 T5N-R15E  The South 183 feet of the North 338 feet of the Southeast 1/4 lying Northeast of County Road # 845
The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:  A twelve feet wide easement on said land running Southwest from an existing pole as shown on attached Right of Way drawing # 232284/5.
<ol> <li>Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.</li> <li>Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.</li> <li>Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures are allowed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.</li> <li>Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in The Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.</li> <li>Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee will restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.</li> <li>Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors and assigns.</li> </ol>
