



## Detroit Edison Overhead Easement (Right of Way) No. 304221

On August. 22 , 2000, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area." "Grantor" is:

Village of North Branch, 4018 Huron St., P. O. Box D, North Branch, MI 48461 "Grantee" is:

The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226

"Grantor's Land" is in North Branch Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as: Parcels 1,2,3,4 and 5 combined: Part of the East ½ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 4, T9N-R11E, described as beginning at a point on the East-West ¼ line that is South 88°14'10" West 803 feet from the East ¼ corner of said Section 4; thence South 01°27'54" East 510 feet; thence South 88°14'10" West 509.44 feet; thence along the West line of said East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4, North 01°27'54" West 510 feet; thence along said East-West 1/4 line, North 88°14'10" East 509.44 feet to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as: A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures are allowed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in The Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee will restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.

6. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors and assigns. Village of North Branch
