The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226.

"Grantor's Land" is in Arcadia Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as: See Attachment "A"

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures are allowed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Excavation: Under 1974 Public Act 53, you must call MISS DIG (1-800-482-7171) before excavating in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in The Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences can be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee will not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee will restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors and assigns.

Parcel D: Part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 3, T8N-R11E, Arcadia Township, Lapeer County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point on the West section line that is North 00° 12' 25" West 556.95' from the Southwest corner of said Section 3, thence continuing along said West section line, North 00° 12' 25" West 300.00', thence North 89° 14' 01" East 1048.95', thence along the Westerly line of the former P.O. & N. 
