## Detroit Edison Overhead and Underground Easement (Right of Way) No. 407452

On \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2002, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent overhead and underground easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area."

## "Grantor's Land" is in Marathon Township, Lapeer County, Michigan described as:

Parcel C-1: Part of the Northwest ¼ of Section 1, T9N-R9E, Marathon Township, Lapeer County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point on the West section line that is North 00° 30′ 00″ West 606.14′ from the West ¼ corner of said Section 1, thence continuing along said West section, North 00° 30′ 00″ West 401.21′, thence South 87° 40′ 45″ East 791.09′, thence South 00° 07′ 35″ East 333.81′, thence North 87° 38′ 00″ West 428.76′, thence South 00° 07′ 23″ East 57.35′, thence North 89° 18′ 57″ West 359.43′ to the point of beginning.

Parcel C-2: Part of the Northwest ¼ of Section 1, T9N-R9E, Marathon Township, Lapeer County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point that is North 00° 30' 00" West 1007.35' along the West section line and South 87° 40' 45" East 791.09' from the West ¼ corner of said Section 1, thence continuing South 87° 40' 45" East 300.00', thence South 00° 07' 29" East 334.05', thence North 87° 38' 00" West 300.00', thence North 00° 07' 35" West 333.81' to the point of beginning.

Parcel C-3: Part of the Northwest ¼ of Section 1, T9N-R9E, Marathon Township, Lapeer County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point that is North 00° 30' 00" West 1007.35' along the West section line and South 87° 40' 45" East 1091.09' from the West ¼ corner of said Section 1, thence continuing South 87° 40' 45" East 265.00', thence South 00° 07' 23" East 334.26', thence North 87° 38' 00" West 265.00', thence North 00° 07' 29" West 334.05' to the point of beginning.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as: A 12' wide easement as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

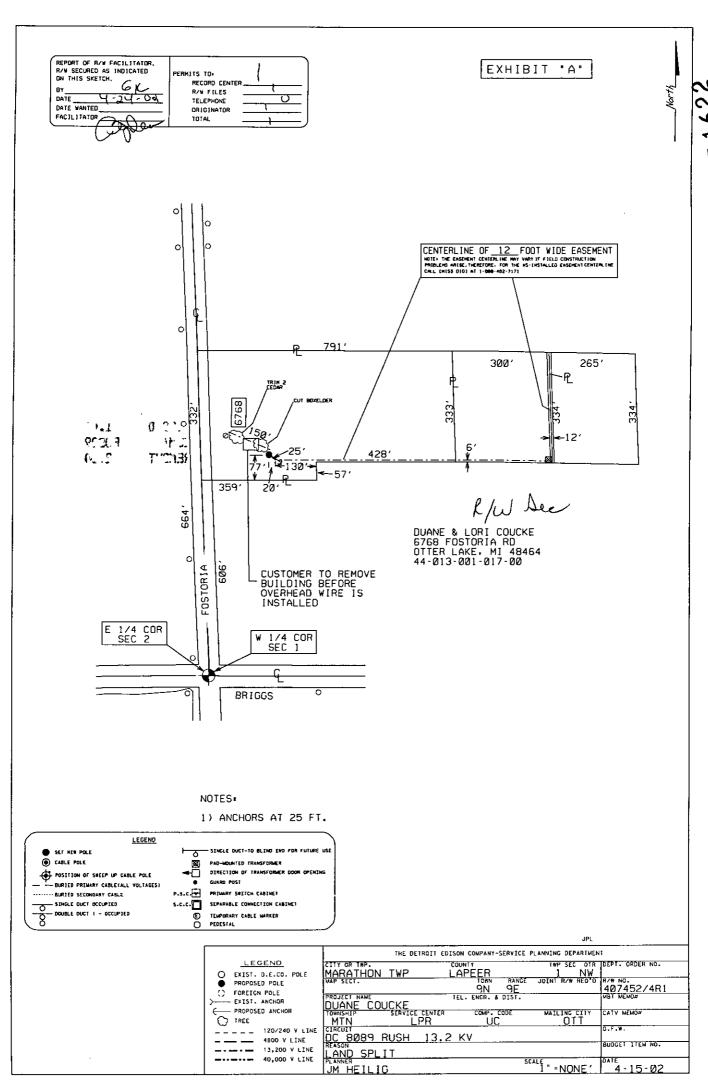
- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- **3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures:** No buildings or other permanent structures are allowed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- **4. Excavation:** Under 1974 Public Act 53, you must call MISS DIG (1-800-482-7171) before excavating in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in The Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences can

be planted, grown or installed with... 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee will not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.

- **6. Restoration:** If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee will restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors and assigns.
