, 2001, for the consideration of system betterment, Grantor grants to Grantee a permanent underground easement ("Right of Way") in, on and across a part of Grantor's Land called the "Right of Way Area." "Grantor" is:

"Grantor's Land" is in the NE 1/4 of Section 34, City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan

Lots 33 to 36 inclusive of Supervisor's Plat No. 5 lying northerly of M-59 except the North 20 feet taken for Auburn Road, also all of Lot 37 lying Northerly of M-59as recorded in Liber 6 of plats, page 55, Oakland County Records. Sidwell Number 15-34-127-006

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

A ten (10) foot easement as shown on attached sketch #331801-56. The easement is ten (10) foot wide.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures are allowed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Excavation: Under 1974 Public Act 53, you must call MISS DIG (1-800-482-7171) before excavating in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in The Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences can be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee will not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors.
- 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee will restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 7. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors and
