The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, west of and adjacent to the West line of the Michigan Central Railroad right of way

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay me the sum of Twenty 20.00 Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.
