County of... Cheboygan... and State of Michigan, to-wit: Parcel 134 A (Partial): --

"That part of the East 1/2 of Section 1, T35N, R3W, Tuscarora Township, Cheboygan County, Michigan described as: Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Section 1; thence West along the section line, 130.67 feet; thence Northwesterly along a 7 deg 00' curve to the left, 23.16 feet to P.T. It is expressly understood that non-use or a limited use of this easement by second party shall not prevent second party from later making use of the easement to the full extent herein authorized.
