Michigan Ave., Jackson, Michigan, second party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, convey ... and warrant ... to the second party, its successors and assigns, forever, the easement and right to erect, lay and maintain lines consisting of ~~wires~~ poles, wires, cables, conduits and other fixtures and appurtenances for the purpose of transmitting and distributing electricity and/or conducting a communication business on, over, under and across the following described parcel ... of land, including all public highways upon or adjacent to said parcel ... of land, which parcel ... is ... situate in the Township ... of ... County of ... and State of Michigan, to-wit:

The East one-half (1/2) of the Northeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 35, Township 34 North, Range 5 West.

The route to be taken by said lines of ~~wires~~ poles, wires, cables and conduits across, over and under said land being more specifically described as follows: Second party may locate sd. route on, over and across sd. above desc. land along or adjoining as near as practicable a line, which sd. line is desc. as beg. at a point not more than 100 ft. East of the West line of Sec. 36, T34N, R5W, at a point not more than 300 ft. North of the South, East and West eighth line of sd. Sec., run th. Northwesterly to a point not more than 900 ft. nor less than 700 ft. South of the North line of sd. Sec. 35 at a point not more than 450 ft. nor less than 250 ft. East of the North and South quarter line of sd. Sec.

With full right and authority to the second party, its successors, licensees, lessees or assigns, and its and their agents and employees, to enter at all times upon said premises for the purpose of constructing, repairing, removing, replacing, patrolling, improving, enlarging and maintaining such cables, conduits, ~~wires~~ poles and other supports, with all necessary braces, guys, anchors, manholes and transformers, and stringing thereon and supporting and suspending therefrom lines of wire, cables or other conductors for the transmission of electrical energy and/or communication, and to trim, remove, destroy or otherwise control any trees and brush which may, in the opinion of said second party, interfere or threaten to interfere with or be hazardous to the construction, operation and maintenance of said lines. It is expressly understood that no buildings or other structures will be placed under such wires and/or over such cables without the written consent of said second party. It is expressly understood that non-use or a limited use of this easement by second party shall not prevent second party from later making use of the easement to the full extent herein authorized. Second party to pay at the rate of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per mile of length of the line of poles and wires across said above described premises, the same to be paid before any work is done on the land, and also to pay for any damage to crops in erecting and maintaining said line of poles and wires.


