Isabella... and State of Michigan, to-wit: The Northwest one-quarter (1/4) of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section twenty-eight (28), Township thirteen (13) North, Range three (3) West, except the Ann Arbor Railroad right of way off the East side thereof.

It is expressly understood that no buildings or other structures will be placed under such wires and/or over such cables without the written consent of said second party. It is expressly understood that non-use or a limited use of this easement by second party shall not prevent second party from later making use of the easement to the full extent herein authorized.
