- 4. All commercial forest products out by permittee hereunder shall be the property of the Department of Conservation and shall be cut and piled or decked as directed by this Department's authorized representatives.
- 5. Permittee and its employees shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent and suppress forest fires; shall cause no unnecessary damage to natural tree growth or to any plantation; and shall be responsible for any demage other than ordinary to state property.
- 6. Before burning any refuse or setting any Pires whatsoever, permittee shall obtain the required permit from this Department's authorized representatives.
- 6-A. The use of herbicides to control tree, shrub, and other plant growth on lands herein described shall not be permitted unless written permission to do so is first obtained from the Grantor's authorized field representative.
