Real Estate and Rights of Way Overhead Right of Way Agreement

For good and valuable consideration of system betterment, the undersigned hereby grant and convey to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a Michigan corporation of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON," the right to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories required to provide electric services in, upon, over and across property located in the City of Farmington Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, further described as follows:

The Northerly 12 ft. of the following described property: Part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 17, T1N, R9E, beginning at a point distant North 00°06'00" West 592.12 ft. and North 00°16'00" West 181.72 ft. and South 83°00'37" West 349.60 ft. from Intersection of center line of Howard Road with North and South 1/4 line, thence South 01°41'00" East 279.51 ft., thence North 76°46'00" West 126 ft., thence North 04°59'00" West 232 ft., thence along curve to the right, radius 11459.16 ft., chord bears North 81°48'12" East 136 ft., distance of 136 ft. to point of beginning.

The right of way is twelve (12) feet in width

The rights hereby granted include the right of access to and from the right of way and the right to trim, each dewn or otherwise control brush and trees either within the right of way or on property adjoining the right of way which in the opinion of EDISON interferes with the construction or operation of the line facilities. It is expressly understood and agreed that EDISON shall, at no time, trim or cut down any trees unless, in EDISON'S opinion, it is absolutely necessary to do so. EDISON shall restore premises to its original condition or as near as can be in the event of damages caused by its employes, contractors, vehicles and equipment entering premises for the purposes set forth herein. No buildings or structures are to be placed within said right of way herein granted without the written consent of the GRANTEE. This grant is declared to be binding upon the heirs, successors, lessees, licensees and assigns of the parties hereto.
