Gentlemen:


Your letter of March 2 enclosing blueprints of the proposed construction on East New Hampshire Avenue received.

I am enclosing one copy, which has been approved subject to the conditions set forth in this letter.

Permission is granted to make the proposed installation, on condition that all existing improvements shall remain unaltered, and that the parkway be replaced immediately after construction in the same condition as before work was commenced. It is understood that the Detroit Edison Company will remunerate the City of Pleasant Ridge for any expense incurred in re-grading or re-sodding the parkway and replacement of any trees or shrubbery damaged.
