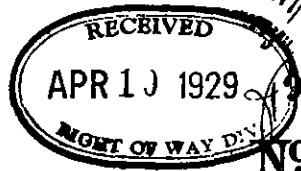

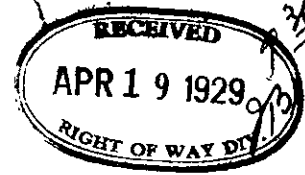

Attention, Mr. T. L. Hinks:

Gentlemen:

Your request of April 10th for permission to install 12-4" fibre ducts, and the necessary manholes and drains for same, has been referred to this office for investigation and reply.

On Knowles Street, from Seventh Street to Sixth Street, you propose to locate the underground conduit one foot East of the East edge of the West sidewalk. On Sixth Street, between Knowles Street and Kayser Street, the proposed location of the conduit is one foot South of the South edge of the North sidewalk; and from Kayser Street to a point East of Irving Avenue, the proposed location is four feet South of the South edge of the North sidewalk. The proposed locations are approved by this office, providing you agree to the following stipulations:

- 1- That proper care will be exercised to protect all underground structures, and that you will be liable for all damage thereto.
- 2- That the trench opened for this work shall be back-filled by machine tamping for the entire depth of the excavation, or by flushing, if the soil conditions permit.
- 3- That you will bear the entire cost of pavement repairs.
- 4- That the work shall be done in such sequence as to maintain traffic at all times.
- 5- That you will provide gravel or cinders as a surface course in such places as are necessary to be kept open to traffic until such time as it would be feasible to replace concrete.
- 6- The City of Royal Oak is not liable in any way whatsoever for damage suits or other claims arising through these operations.
- 7- The City of Royal Oak shall have the right to place an Inspector on the job if deemed advisable, and the cost of such inspection shall be borne by the Detroit Edison Company.

- 8- That you agree to construct new sidewalks to conform with the City's specifications, and grades established by the Engineering Department, wherever any existing sidewalk is damaged.

It is noted that it will be necessary to cross new concrete pavements at Seventh Street, Sixth Street, Kayser Street, and Irving Avenue. If it is possible to install the conduits at these intersections without cutting the pavement slab we would much prefer that the work be done in such a manner. If it is not possible we request that only those cuts be made in the concrete pavements which are absolutely necessary in carrying out this work.

Enclosed please find blueprint No. U-380-755, which has been approved.

Acknowledgement of this letter, agreeing to the stipulations set forth, will be your authorization to proceed with the work.
