If you see no objection to the installing of this conduit, will you kindly approve and return copy of this letter?

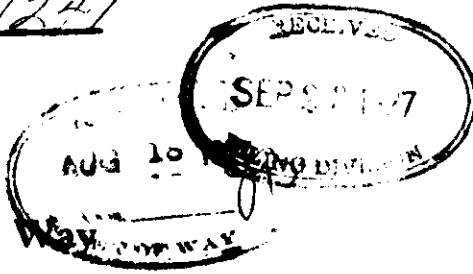
