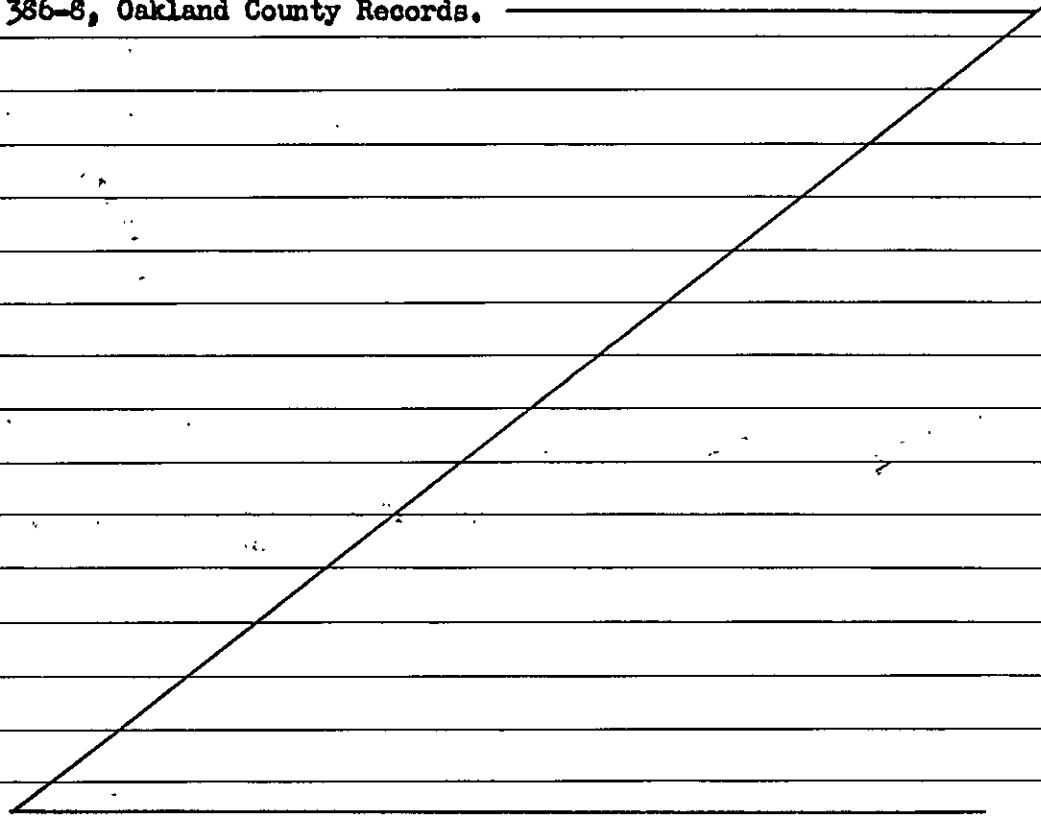
Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations dollars,

So much of Lot No. 6 of Assessor's Plat No. 2, Part of the S.W. 1/4, Sec. 7, T. 5 N., R. 9 E., Village of Ortonville, Oakland County, Michigan, as is bounded westerly by the easterly line of Lot 9 of said Assessor's Plat No. 2, southerly by extension easterly of the northerly line of Lot No. 10 of said Assessor's Plat No. 2; northerly by extension easterly of the southerly line of Lot No. 8 of said Assessor's Plat No. 2, and easterly by Cedar Street.
