acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever QUIT-CLAIM

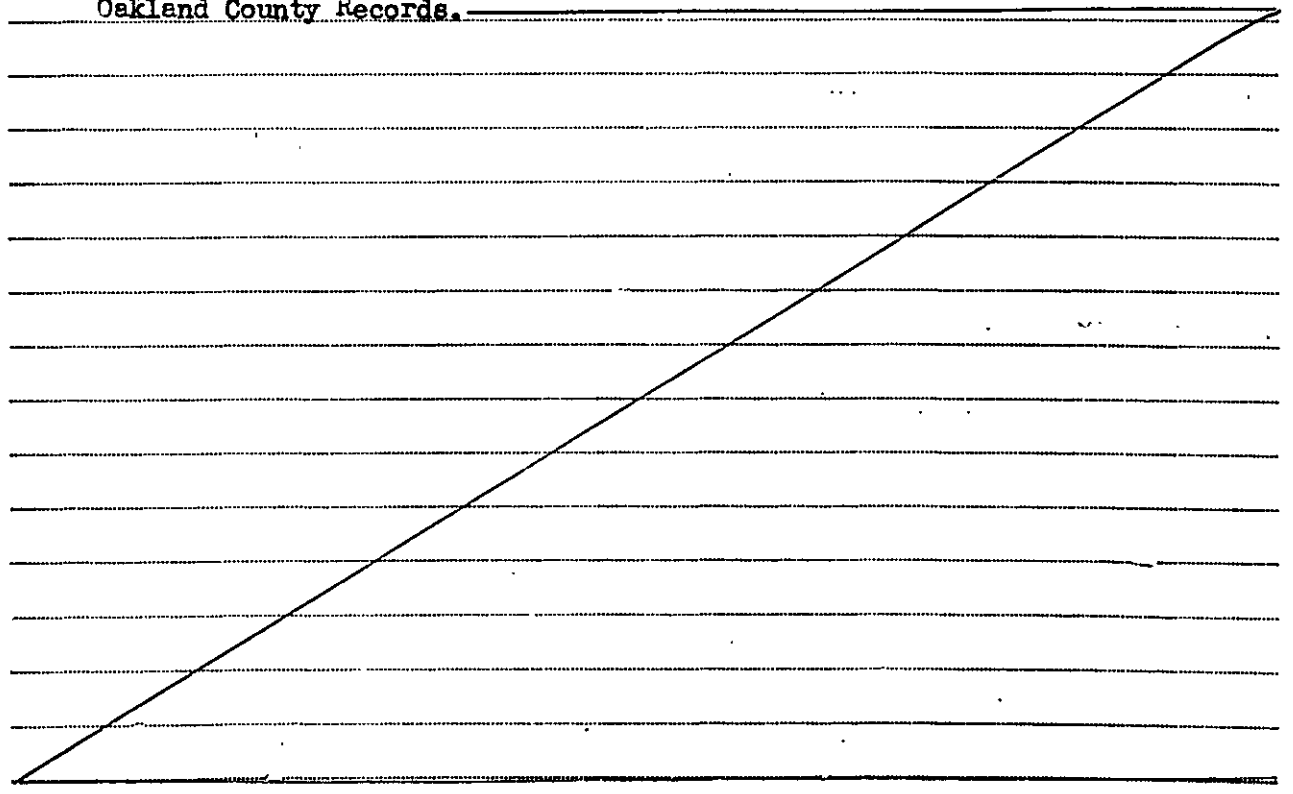
unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, Forever, All
