THE WEST 20 FEET OF THE SOUTH 30 FEET OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY, PART OF THE NE 1/4 OF SECTION 36, T14N, R10E, BEGINNING AT THE NE SECTION CORNER, THENCE S 1° 15' E 1249.01 FT, THENCE S 89° 33' 30" W 780 FT THENCE N 1° 15' W 1249.01 FT, THENCE N 89° 33' 30" E 780 FT TO THE BEGINNING, EXCEPT N 60 FT AND E 60 FT IN HWY.
