We IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across our property located in Township of Southfield

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The South 6 feet of the following described property: Part of the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 32, Town 1 North, Range 10 East, described as commencing at the Southeast corner of said Section 32; thence North 87°45'21" West on Section line 213.96 feet to Westerly line of 204 feet Telegraph Road; thence North 15°07' East along Westerly line (CONTINUED ON REVERSE SIDE)

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an Easterly and Westerly direction along the South line.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and 00/100 (\$5.00) -- Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
