

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in the CITY OF ROYAL OAK, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lots 14 through 38 inclusive and Lot 41 of Kensington Highland Subdivision.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

In a Northerly and Southerly direction from a point on the South line of Lot 1, approximately 45 ft. Easterly from the West property line, to a point on the North line of Lot 30, approximately 25 ft. East of West property line and continuing Northerly to the North line of Lot 50 parallel to and approximately 25 ft. Easterly from the West lot lines, as shown on attached sketch.

It is understood and agreed that poles will be located at side property lines of parcels as established by the grantors

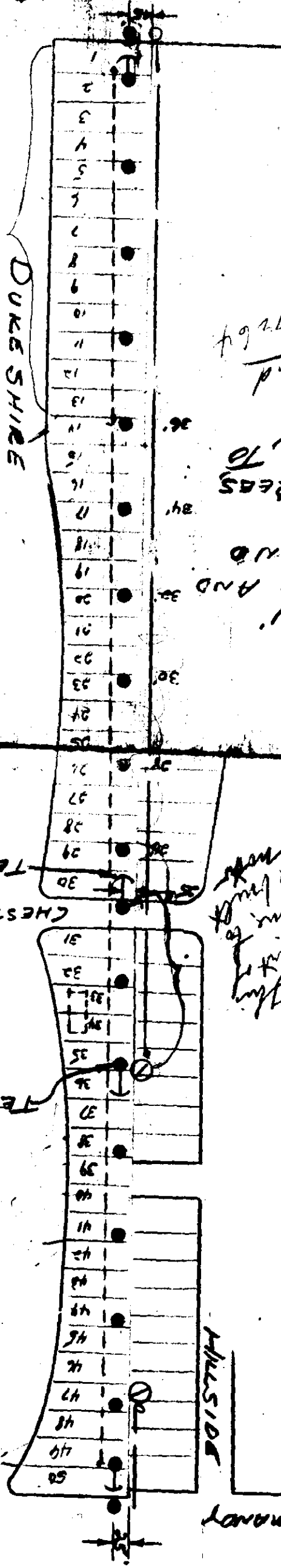
