IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in _____

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

A parcel of land in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T1N, R1E, described as: beginning at a point which is located N 0°6'30" W 200 ft along the W'ly line of said Section, from the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 35 as established and monumented by the C. W. Harrah's Ferndale Subdivision No. 2; thence N 0°6'30" W along the said W'ly section line 393.41 ft to a point; thence S 29°34'30" E along the original W'ly Grand Trunk Western R.R. right-of-way line 451.78 ft to a point; thence S 89°53'30" W and parallel with the N'ly E and W 1/8 line of said section 222.26 ft to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

In a NW'ly and SE'ly direction across said land along SW'ly of and adjacent to the SW'ly line of the Grand Trunk Western R.R. right-of-way.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of One hundred & 1/2 (100.50) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.
