IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in CITY OF ROYAL OAK County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lots 8 and 9, Block 21, Assessor's Plat #20 of Sherman Stevens Plat, known as the Original Plat of the Village of Royal Oak of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 21, T 1 N, R 11 E, and the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Sec. 22, T 1 N, R 11 E, CITY OF ROYAL OAK, Oakland County, Michigan, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 53 of Plats, pages 33 and 33A, Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:
Overhang of wires only along West of and parallel and adjacent to the Grand Trunk Railroad right-of-way.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay US the sum of Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars for said right-of-way on said land, the same to be paid before any wires are erected.
