I hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across my property located in _____

County of OAKLAND, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lots 370, 371 and 372 of Starr Acres Subdivision of part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, T 1 N, R 11 E, recorded in Liber 23 of Plats, Page 15, lying West of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Overhang of wires only along West of and adjacent to the right-of-way of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay me the sum of Seventy-Five and 95/100 (75.95) above right-of-way wires Dollars for such on said land, the same to be paid before any work are effected.
