The north 383 ft of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 29 T1N, R1E (C11.61A)

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an Easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the northern property line and extending approx. 103 ft West of the Easterly line of Colledge Highway.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
