Fourteen Mile Road, Royal Oak, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "PINTEN," desires to petition the Common Council of the City of Royal Oak to vacate the above described portions of Samoset Road, Nakota Road and Edgeland Avenue; and

WHEREAS, PINTEN has requested that EDISON file no objection to the vacation of the aforementioned portions of Samoset Road, Nakota Road and Edgeland Avenue by reason of its having its equipment for the transmission and distribution of electricity located therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of EDISON'S consent to the vacation of the aforementioned streets, and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, PINTEN does by these presents grant to EDISON, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines which could fall into the lines or

interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across certain property located in the City of Royal Oak. County of Oakland and State of Michigan, described as follows:

> That portion of Edgeland Avenue located between the north line of Samoset Road and the south line of Fourteen Mile Road, being in Nordwood Estates Subdivision, as recorded in Liber 13 of Plats, page 31, Oakland County Records.

EDISON, upon ninety (90) days written notice thereof and payment by PINTEN of the cost therefor in advance, shall completely remove its lines, equipment and facilities from the land over which this easement is hereby granted. PINTEN, however, covenants and agrees that the advance payment for the cost of the removal of the lines, equipment and facilities shall be made before such removal is effected and shall be in such amount as is computed by EDISON, which sum shall include all of EDISON'S costs and expenses attributable directly or indirectly to such removal.

Provided, however, that EDISON shall not remove two poles now situated respectively in said Edgeland Avene approximately on the south line of Forteen Mile Road and approximately one hundred twenty (120) feet south of the south line of the Fourteen Mile Road, together with three (3) sections of primary lines which are connected to said poles.
