IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in

City of Hazel Park

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The West 75 feet of the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, T 1 N R 11 E except the South 520 feet more or less.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 35 feet east of the west line.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT FOR MICHIGAN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY

It is further understood that the Michigan Bell Telephone Company is hereby given the right to cut and trim from time to time any and all trees and brush along said lines which may interfere therewith.
