construct, operate and maintain its underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary conduits, fixtures, cables, manholes and equipment under and across our property located in

The City of Oak Park, County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Beginning at a Point South 0°4'50" West 2083 feet from the N.E. Corner of Section 30, T1N. R1E, Thence South 89°43'50" West 60 feet, Thence North 0°4'50" East 300 feet, Thence North 89°43'50" East 60 feet, Thence South to the point of beginning excepting that part being used for roads.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across and under the southerly 260 feet of said land approximately 20 feet west of the East line, also in an easterly and westerly direction across and under the easterly 20 feet of said land approximately 40 feet south of the north line.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
