IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One and no/100 (1.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary conduits, fixtures, cables, manholes and equipment, under and across our property located in The City of Oak Park, County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The East 314 feet of the South 115 feet of the North 1990 feet of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 30, T1N. R11E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across and under said land along approximately 50 feet westerly of the center line of Coolidge Highway.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
